







MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

between

the College of Education and Therapy with its seat in Poznan, Poland, represented by the Rector – professor Kazimiera Milanowska, MD, Ph.D.

and

Bayero University with its seat in Kano, Nigeria, represented by the Vice-Chancellor – professor Abubakar A. Rasheed, mni, MFR

The College of Education and Therapy and Bayero University,

enter into a general agreement of mutually beneficial co-operation. The aim of the co-operation is to maintain permanent contacts between academic teachers and students, undertake joint actions, promote and exchange achievements and co-operate in the areas of teaching, science, research and administration.

§ 1

The scope of co-operation between the Parties shall include in particular:

- 1. Co-operation in improvement of teaching qualifications of academic teachers, development of contacts between research staff, including teacher mobility.
- 2. Co-operation in the teaching of students.
- 3. Exchange of experience and information concerning the structure and content of the curricula and organisation of the teaching processes.
- 4. Joint organisation and carrying out of research and exchange of the results of research.
- 5. Exchange of teaching materials, books, university periodicals and scientific literature.
- 6. Exchange of experience in administration and management of universities.
- 7. Joint applications for funds to finance co-operation projects.
- 8. Mutual assistance and support for the actions undertaken by both institutions to participate in international teaching and research programmes.

§ 2

The co-operation in the areas specified in paragraph 1 of the agreement shall include in particular:

- 1. Academic teachers exchange, including series of guest lectures, training, as well as research and education fellowships.
- 2. Visits and meetings of delegations at the universities.
- 3. Organisation of seminars, conferences, scientific workshops and training.
- 4. Joint research.

- 5. Joint scientific and educational publications.
- 6. Exchange of information concerning opportunities for co-operation.
- 7. Participation in international bilateral and multilateral scientific and educational programmes.

§ 3

The co-operation is based on the principles of equal treatment and mutual benefit of both universities, with their involvement - respective to their capabilities.

§ 4

The financial conditions of the co-operation shall be agreed separately every time for each individual form of co-operation, taking into consideration the financial capabilities of both universities.

§ 5

In order to fulfil the provisions of the Agreement, an annex - subject to approval by the rectors of both universities, shall be attached to it containing details of the scope and form of the planned co-operation.

§ 6

- 1. The Agreement has been made for unspecified time.
- Each Party has the right to terminate the Agreement with a one month notice period.

§ 7

- 1. Any changes in the Agreement shall be null and void unless made in writing.
- 2. Any dispute arising from this agreement does not confer on any party the right to enforce it in court of low but to resolve it through a conciliator appointed and accepted by both parties

§ 8

The agreement was made in Polish and in English, in two identical copies in each language, one for each Party.
